KB-01	Ayurvedic genetics, embryology & teratology: Fetal anatomy & physiology-their consideration in relation to treatment after birth - developmental window period in relation to teratogens – ayurvedic drugs and panchakarma procedures, and their teratological effects - Preconceptional and antenatal maternal ahar, vihar and aushadha and their beneficial or adverse effects on fetal development and final outcome - Intranatal maternal health issues and their effects on fetus and final outcome
KB-02	Neonatology: Post natal physiological differences in relation to various illnesses and their consideration during treatment including selection of the drugs and their dose
KB-03	Infant care & early intervention in developing health issues
KB-04	Neurology including various types of neurological disorders, learning disabilities, delayed development, dyslexia, ADHD, ASD, etc.
KB-05	Gastroenterological conditions such as ulcerative colitis, IBS, Hirschsprung disease, etc.
KB-06	Uronephrological conditions such as nephritis, nephrotic syndrome, CRF, VUJ obstruction or PUJ obstruction, urolithiasis, etc.

KB-08	Pediatric CVS disorders
KB-09	Pediatric endocrinological disorders like juvenile diabetes mellitus, thyroid dysfunctions, etc.

KB-14	Pediatric hematology e.g. thalassemia, sickle cell anemia, ITTP and other bleeding disorders, etc.
KB-15	Adolescent issues - Addiction to tobacco and its products, drug addiction and de-addiction
KB-16	Child psychology: Manas prakriti - Addiction to internet, video game, mobile, etc.
KB-17	Dushivisha in relation to the field of pediatrics
KB-18	Autoimmune disorders, obesity, and other life style disorders
KB-19	Pharmacodynamics, pharmacokinetics, pharmacogenetics and proteomics of single drugs (both herbal and herbo-mineral) used in clinical pediatrics e.g. vacha, brahmi, shankhapushpi, godanti bhasma, etc.
KB-20	Pediatrics ENT, ophthalmology and dentistry
KB-21	Clinical application of panchakarma in pediatrics
KB-22	Yoga and meditation, and their clinical application in pediatrics
KB-23	Remaining topics in the field of pediatrics, not mentioned here
